MGCC Anglia Summer Picnic at Anglesey Abbey (NT)

The Anglia Summer Picnic is being held on Sunday 8th June at Anglesey Abbey, Lode in Cambridgeshire.

Built on the site of a 12th century Augustinian priory the house dates from 1600. Lord Fairhaven who remodelled it into a country home bought Anglesey Abbey in 1926. It houses the extensive Fairhaven collection of antiques and fine art. He also created the gardens blending formal design, an arboretum and open parkland covering some 98 acres in all. There are over 100 pieces of sculpture on view. The working Lode Mill (watermill) regularly grinds grain for sale.

On site facilities include a visitor centre with restaurant, shop, plant sales and a second-hand bookshop.

6 miles north east of Cambridge on B1102. Signposted from A14, junction 35.

Admission to House, Park and Grounds is at a rate of £10.50 for Adults and £5.00 for Children between 5 and 18. The cost includes admission to House, Gardens and Lode mill.

Note - <u>National Trust Members</u> entry is by their membership card – but please advise me for planning purposes (no SAE needed). Email is fine. NT members are asked to make a £1 donation on the day towards costs.

There will be an exclusive parking and picnic area for MG Car Club members.
