2025 promises to be a very important year for MG CAR CLUB of Italy as it will be our turn to organize the European Event of the Year, a certainly burdensome task due to the numbers that such an event is able to express but which at the same time makes us proud and enthusiastic.
The base chosen is that of the Euganean Baths which, thanks to its huge hotel offer, allows us to face a similar number of expected participants with serenity.
Furthermore, this location will allow us to offer excursions in the Veneto area, now known as the Land of Venice, which offers many UNESCO heritage sites to visit and ideal roads for our MGs who will arrive from all over Europe and beyond.

- starting from 11:00 a.m. departure in staggered groups for Monselice, followed by a visit to the city [26 km]



Monselice Castle is a complex of buildings that is made up of four main nuclei. The oldest part is the Castelletto with the adjoining Romanesque House, built between the 11th and 12th centuries. In 1935, Count Vittorio Cini began a radical restoration of the entire complex of buildings, introducing a vast collection of medieval and Renaissance objects. You can relive a magical atmosphere, as if by magic the ancient inhabitants of these places were to reappear to take possession of them and relive the heroic and daily deeds of their times.

Prato della Valle, one of the symbols of Padua, is the second largest square in Italy and the sixth in Europe. Its ellipse of almost 90,000 square meters, is a large monumental space characterized by a central green island, called Isola Memmia, surrounded by a circular canal adorned with 78 statues.

Four avenues cross the Prato on small bridges, to then meet in the center of the islet.

Basilica di S. Giustina, Orto Botanico, Basilica di S. Antonio, Via del Santo, Palazzo della Ragione, Piazza della Frutta e Piazza delle Erbe, Palazzo del Bo, la Specola, Cappella degli Scrovegni, Museo d'Arte Medievale e Moderna.

Beauty, art, culture and tradition intertwine among the hills that go from Conegliano to Valdobbiadene along ancient paths and fascinating places scattered in what is considered the first Italian wine area.

- visit at Cantina Villa Sandi and Vintage Aircrafts exhibition at Fondazione Jonathan



Villa Sandi is a perfect example of the union between art and agriculture that has characterized the Veneto landscape of past centuries. Located between the DCG areas of Prosecco di Valdobbiadene and the DOC areas of Montello and Colli Asolani wines, the Villa is a splendid Palladian-style building dating back to 1622. The homonymous winery is among the Top 100 of the World's Best Vineyards.



La Fondazione "Jonathan Collection – Aerei Storici Famosi – O.N.L.U.S." is a young organization established with the aim of spreading the historical memory of aviation and promoting flight activity as a historical and social value. The activity focuses mainly on reliving the emotion of flight with aircrafts that date back to 80-100 years ago.
