## MGCC THE F G BARNES MG TROPHY

The MG Trophy is the Premier Race Championship run by the MG Car Club and caters for MGZR & MG3 saloons in three classes. Class A is for the full race specification ZR190 & MG3 190 cars running on control slicks/wets. Class B is for modified ZR170 cars using a list 1B control tyre and Class C is for almost standard ZR160 cars, again using a list 1B control tyre.

Class A cars carry Orange sun strips, Class B Yellow, and Class C White. All classes have designated rear number plates.

The Driver of the Race award is sponsored by Millers Oils NanOdrive.

For 2023 we are supporting the charity Autism Early Support, all cars will display their sticker on the windscreen.
